

RESOLUTION NO. 8450

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA ESTABLISHING A ONE-WAY STREET ON WEST 126TH STREET FROM HAWTHORNE BOULEVARD TO GREVILLEA AVENUE, ESTABLISHING ANGLED PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST 126TH STREET FROM HAWTHORNE BOULEVARD TO GREVILLEA AVENUE AND DESIGNATING THIRTY-FOUR SPACES AS A PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Vehicle Code Section 21657 authorizes the City Council to designate any highway, roadway, part of a roadway, or specific lanes upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one direction at all or such times as shall be indicated by official traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 10.36 of the Hawthorne Municipal Code authorize the City Council to designate streets or portions of streets along which angle parking of vehicles will reduce parking congestion to the benefit of the public and where surrounding conditions are such that the free movement of traffic will not be interfered with by that method of parking; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 10.38 of the Hawthorne Municipal Code and Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorize the City Council to designate preferential parking privileges to members of organizations, professions, or designated groups as long as parking conditions for residents are not adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, for several years, City staff have made complaints regarding the lack of available parking at City Hall and on-street parking, particularly on the days of street sweeping; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hawthorne will expand City Hall, requiring additional parking designated for City officials and staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California as follows:

SECTION 1. West 126th Street from Hawthorne Boulevard to Grevillea Avenue is to become a one-way street, in which vehicular traffic shall proceed westbound at all times.

SECTION 2. Forty-six (46) parking spaces are to be created as angled parking on the south side of West 126th Street from Hawthorne Boulevard to Grevillea Avenue.

SECTION 3. That the Director of Public Works is hereby instructed to install the appropriate signs and markings designating thirty-four (34) of the aforesaid forty-six (46) angled parking spaces on the south side of West 126th Street from the hotel driveway to Grevillea Avenue as a preferential parking zone for the exclusive use by City employees during working hours of 6am to 6pm, Monday through Friday.

SECTION 4. Preferential parking permits for the aforementioned thirty-four (34) parking spaces shall be issued to City employees.

SECTION 5. All other resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
