





SUBJECT:

Appropriation of \$328,789 from 325-6101-601-0-0-40514, for Jim Thorpe Ball Diamond Improvements by Community Services Department

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Staff Recommends that the City Council approve the financial contributions and project framework for the Dodgers Dreamfield at Jim Thorpe Park.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Hawthorne, in collaboration with the Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation and other partners, is working to complete field improvements at Jim Thorpe Park as part of the Dodgers Dreamfield program. This project aims to enhance recreational facilities for local youth, fostering community engagement and promoting sportsmanship. The Dodgers Dreamfield projects serve as vital community assets, promoting health, inclusivity, and economic development. By providing upgraded facilities, these projects help build stronger communities, providing benefits that last for generations. Dodgers Dreamfields number 64 and 65 will provide a focal point for community gatherings, reinforcing pride in local public spaces. They serve as symbols of investment in the community, fostering a sense of ownership and identity. Public-private partnerships like these send a message that the community is valued and supported by organizations such as the Dodgers Foundation.
