Dear Ms. Williams-Hunter:

Currently, there are two Hawthorne business private sector seats on the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB), that have become vacant. The terms of office for these seats will expire on June 30, 2025, and June 30, 2026.

In accordance with federal and State requirements, the Hawthorne Chamber of Commerce nominated Mr. Glenn Grindstaff, Executive Vice President and Chief Human Resources Officer for OSI, Systems, Inc. and Ms. Dawn Harris, Municipal Relationship Manager for Republic Services, to fill vacant seats on the SBWIB as Hawthorne business private sector representatives. The seat expiring June 30, 2025, was previously held by Ms. Tonya Griffin from Republic Services, Ms. Griffin resigned from the South Bay Workforce Investment Board after being promoted and having her assigned service area changed. Mr. Jamin Gallman from SpaceX previously held the business private sector seat on the SBWIB with a term expiring June 30, 2026. Mr. Gallman resigned from the SBWIB after relocating to Texas. We are requesting that the Mayor and City Council please initiate the process to appoint Mr. Grindstaff and Ms. Harris or other business private sector representatives to serve on the SBWIB at the City of Hawthorne's next regularly scheduled City Council meeting or at your earliest convenience.
