

## **RESOLUTION NO. 8280**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ANNUAL ENGINEER'S REPORT, CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT AMOUNTS, AND AUTHORIZING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR IMPROVEMENT OF THE STREET LIGHTING SYSTEM (LANDSCAPING AND STREET LIGHTING ACT OF 1972) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hawthorne intends to levy and collect assessments within the City Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District during Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California has heretofore adopted its Resolution No. 8280 on the 8th day of June 2021, which (1) approved preparation of an engineering report setting forth estimated street lighting assessments for fiscal year 2021-2022 (duly filed with the City Clerk's office) and (2) set a public hearing regarding the levy of the proposed assessment for improvement of the street lighting system (Landscaping and Street Lighting Act of 1972) for said fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City provided published notice of the City Council's public hearing on the street lighting assessment for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the City Council held a duly noticed public hearing on June 8, 2021 pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22625; and

**WHEREAS**, said public hearing has afforded the public ample opportunity to be heard regarding the proposed assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered all evidence, written and oral, submitted to it and has reviewed the annual engineer's report, confirming the assessment diagram and assessments amount.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Hawthorne, California as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that all of the facts set forth in the recitals of this Resolution are true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The proposed diagram and assessment contained in the Engineer's Report, attached as Exhibit "A" to this Resolution, are hereby confirmed and approved and the County Tax Collector is hereby authorized to collect the assessment set forth in the Engineer's Report.

**SECTION 3.** Pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Street Lighting Act of 1972 and the Report of the Engineer, that the estimated amount necessary to maintain and operate the street lighting system and traffic signal lighting within the street lighting maintenance district for the fiscal year 2021-2022 is five hundred seventy-three thousand two hundred fifty-three and sixty-eight cents (\$573,253.68), an assessment for said amount is hereby levied in said district at the rate of \$0.58 per front foot for properties located in Zone 1, \$1.33 per front foot in Zone 2, and \$2.97 per front foot in Zone 3.

**SECTION 4.** In the event that the Hawthorne City Hall remains closed to the public and City Council meetings are held virtually through June 8, 2021, interested parties should review the meeting agenda when published to confirm the public participation process that will be used. Therefore, interested parties are encouraged to provide their comments by phone (310) 349-2915 or by email ([pjimenez@cityofhawthorne.org](mailto:pjimenez@cityofhawthorne.org)) or by leaving their return phone number. Any communication must be received no later than June 8, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.

**SECTION 5.** The City Council adopts Resolution No. 8280 pursuant to Section 22631 of the California Streets & Highway Code.
