SUBJECT:

Markings for On-Street Parking Spaces "Parking T's".

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Staff recommends that City Council approve the expansion of the On-Street Parking Spaces "Parking T's" Pilot Program for the North West Hawthorne neighborhood and authorize the Director of Public Works or his designee to consider requests in other neighborhoods.

DISCUSSION:

In the August 10, 2021, City Council meeting, the On-Street Parking Spaces "Parking T's" Pilot Program was established to allow Public Works to assess the effectiveness of on-street markings. After collecting resident input and receiving positive results to maximize street parking availability, the Staff recommends expanding the program to the North West Hawthorne neighborhood, between El Segundo Boulevard and Imperial Highway from Inglewood Avenue to Hawthorne Boulevard. Engineering Staff will begin considering future requests from residents in other neighborhoods to install "Parking T's" markings.
