A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWTHORNE, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING, APPROVING & RATIFYING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE FY 2023-2024 STATE OF CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP), GRANT NUMBER MC24005

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve Resolution No 8439

DISCUSSION:

The State of California, announced the availability of funds that will be awarded through the Federal Fiscal year 2023-2024 Office of Traffic Safety Selective Enforcement Program (STEP). The goal of our proposed program is to conduct specified traffic related enforcement operations, in conjunction with educational and safety programs, during the grant period (October 2023 – September 2024). Hawthorne Police Department will also use a portion of the grant award to send personnel to ongoing traffic enforcement and supplies necessary to conduct the required enforcement operations and educational programs.

During the grant period, the Hawthorne Police Department will actively participate in several national traffic related safety campaigns, including, but not limited to: National teen Driver Safety Week, National Distracted Driving Awareness Month, Click It or Ticket month, national Motorcycles Safety Month, and California Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety month.

Upon approval of the grant award, the City of Hawthorne will received \$185,000. The grant is financed entirely by OTS funds and does not require a cash or in-kind match. In no case may these

funds be commingled with other Funds, even other federal funds, nor may funds be used to supplant expenses for expenses for which the City of Hawthorne has already appropriated funds.

The Hawthorne Police Department will receive Grant funding in the amount of \$185,000.
